Your ears4U sleeves are handmade with love and attention so that they can nestle nicely in your ear. For optimal comfort, use the appropriate sleeve on the correct ear, which means... The sleeve with the red dot goes on your right inear and the sleeve with the blue dot goes on your left inear.

Grab the sleeve between your thumb and index finger. Look closely at the sleeve, make sure the dot is facing up. Now slowly, carefully and with love and attention bring the sleeve to the ear, turn it a quarter turn back and place it in the ear. This should feel comfortable and NOT painful in any way. If it is painful to wear the sleeve, please contact ears4U immediately.

When you have finished using the inears, do not unwittingly yank them out of your ear. But again with love and attention. Place your thumb at the bottom against the edge of the sleeve and gently push it up and remove the sleeve from your ear. The inears can simply remain on the sleeves.

Regularly check whether the sound openings of the sleeves are free of contamination and earwax. Any blockage can be removed with the supplied hook. The sleeves are provided with an antibacterial lacquer that can be cleaned with a damp cloth and possibly alcohol. If the sleeves are not on the inears, they can be rinsed under the tap.
